Our service includes:

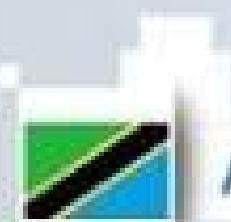
- Advice on formalities, including visa/residence permit, registration, health insurance, employment related issues (in cooperation with HR office)

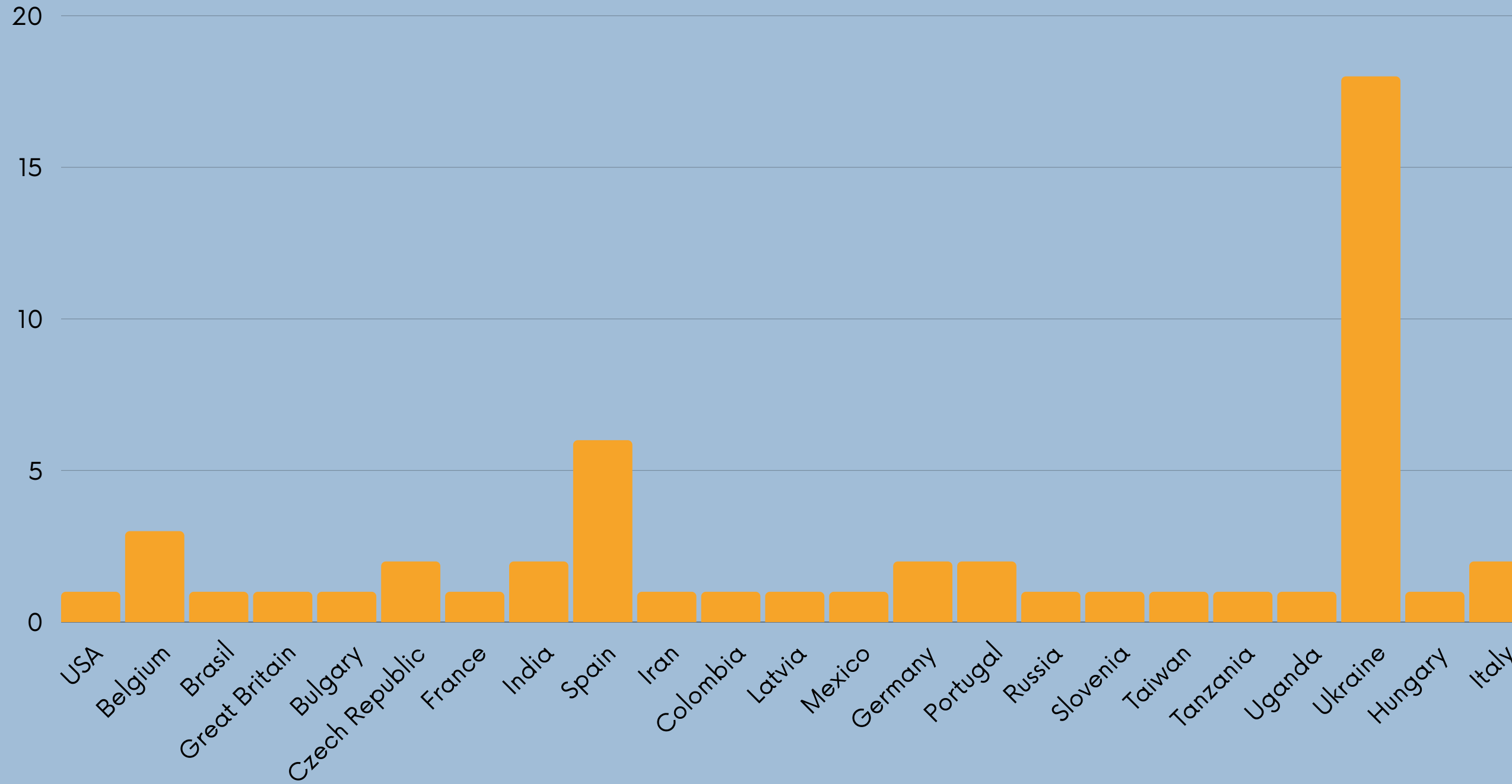

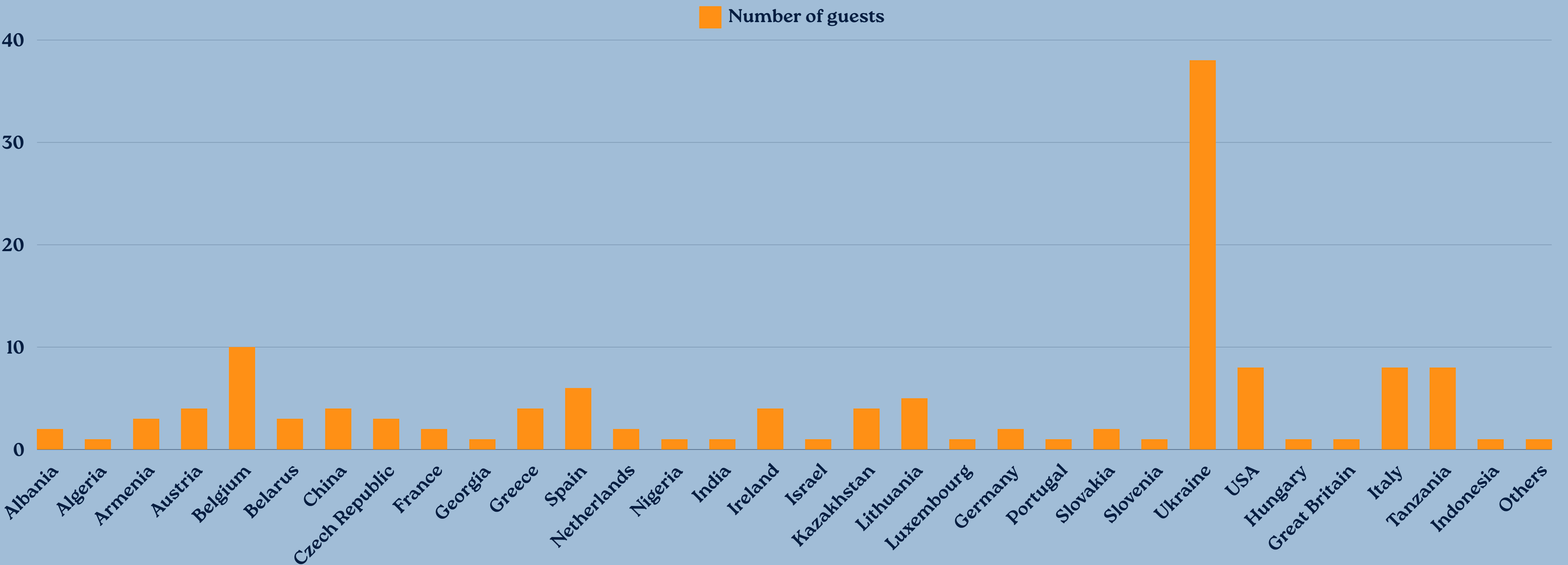

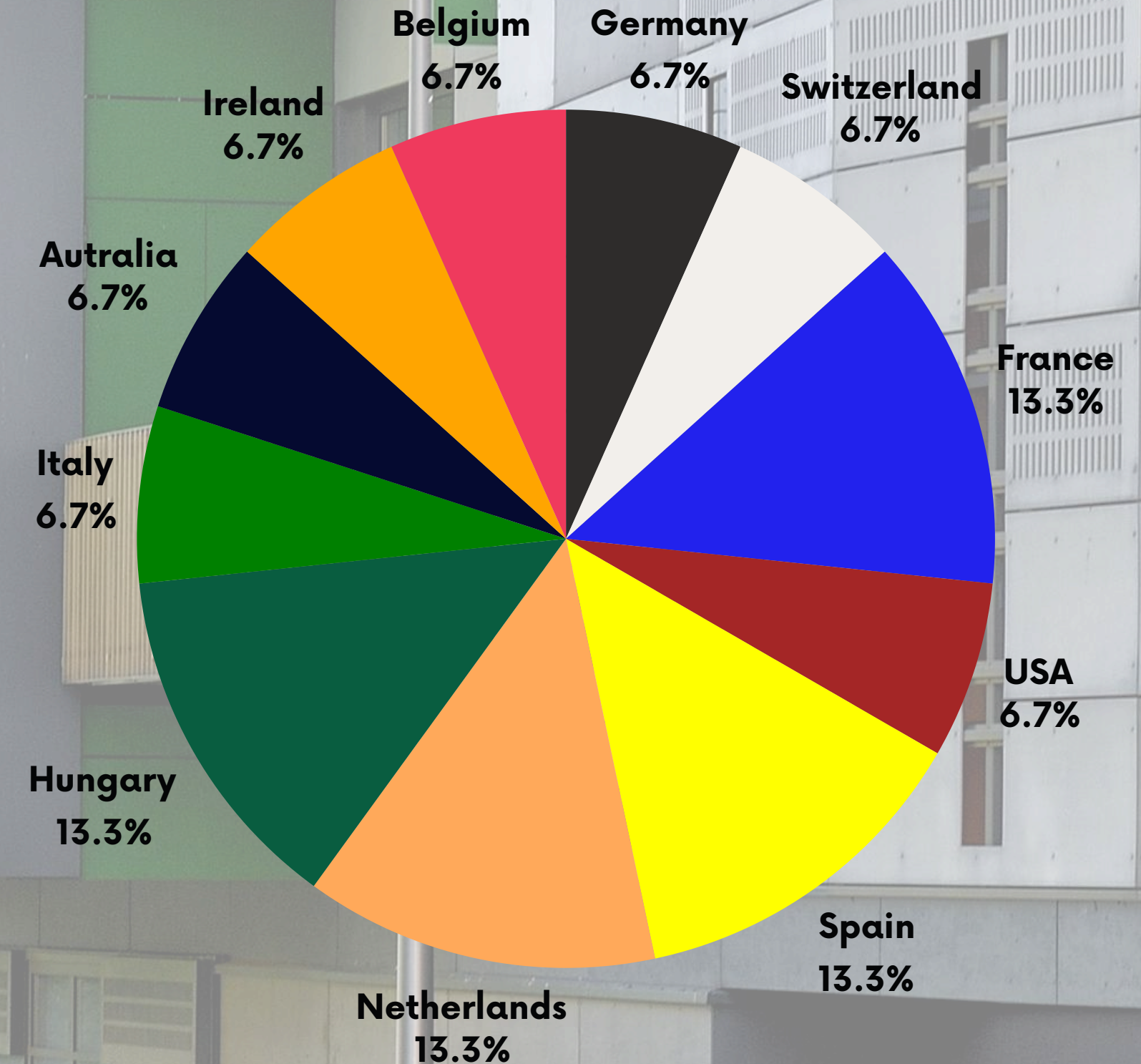
INCOMING MOBILITIES REGISTERED AT UMCS 2023
